- 3 Mrs. Resler opened the floor to the public for comments.  
There being no public comments, Mrs. Resler closed the floor to the public.
- 4 Dr. Sikora reported Dr. Williams has been hosting the parent workshops and the career guide has been a big hit. He shared his own children have been excited about it as well. Hillcrest will have theirs on Wednesday and Oak Forest will be in January.
- 5 Dr. Goggins did not receive any questions regarding personnel recommendations. He informed the board that upon approval of recommendations, all of our schools will have programming 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to assist students who arrive late to school, have credit deficiencies, and are concept deficient.
- 6 Mrs. Morrison did not receive any questions regarding the Bills, Addendum to Bills, Payroll, and CDS Bills. She then discussed the 2022 Tax Levy & Resolutions. Discussion ensued and questions were answered.
- 7 Dr. Williams covered the 2023-24 Calendar and Class Size Review. After discussion, questions were answered. Dr. Williams clarified the start and end dates of school for the 2023-24 school year and the use of e-learning vs. emergency days. She then provided an overview of the class size committee meeting.
- 8 Dr. Boswell provided updates on technology and operations to include website updates, e-gaming teams, Associate principals attended a safety conference, and the Evolve weapons detectors were installed and staff and students are getting adjusted. WAN project is almost completed, and the COPS project awarded to Bremen was one of two schools in the State. This is a savings of almost \$2 million dollars.
- 9 Mr. Baffoe provided an update on buildings and grounds including the digital signs being installed, Hillcrest girls soccer scoreboard has been installed, plow truck has been purchased and delivered, summer 2023 projects, and the ADA bleacher projects.
