## COMMITTEE-OF-THE-WHOLE MEETING MINUTES HILLCREST HIGH SCHOOL ~ TUESDAY, APRIL 11, 2023

- 1 Vice-President Whitcomb called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.
- 2 Board of Education

- 3 Mrs. Resler opened the floor to the public for comments.  
There being no public comments, Mrs. Resler closed the floor to the public.
- 4 Dr. Sikora informed the board that May 2<sup>nd</sup> there will be a special meeting, followed by the reorganization meeting and then the committee of the whole. The next regular board meeting will be May 9<sup>th</sup>. In addition, the senior honors nights are upcoming and a save the date has been sent to the Board.
- 5 Dr. Sikora reported that Dr. Goggins did not receive any questions regarding personnel recommendations. He is closing out negotiations.
- 6 Mrs. Morrison asked if there were any questions received regarding the Bills, Addendum to Bills, Payroll, and CDS Bills, nor the operating budget being opened at 50%. The tentative budget will be presented in July, with final presentation and adoption in September. There were none.
- 7 Dr. Williams explained the memorandum of understanding (MOU) between D228 and D150, South Suburban College to run the welding classes. Discussion occurred with questions answered by Dr. Williams.
- 8 Dr. Boswell discussed the technology purchases for the 23-24 school year, including the purchase of iPads, replacement of desktop computers, and the \$50k grant from ComEd, which will provide an electric car and a charging station. This will be in partnership with the Education Foundation. Additional discussion occurred.
- 9 Dr. Sikora explained on behalf of Mr. Baffoe, that the school chillers are going out to bid, and the parking lot seal coating and striping at Tinley Park and Oak Forest. Mr. Baffoe will explain further if there are any questions.
